BOOKING CONDITIONS

It is advisable that you read the Booking Conditions Prior to travel.

The Company reserves the right to cancel any excursion should bookings be insufficient and full refund will be given.

In the event of severe weather conditions we may have to cancel excursions at the last minute for the safety of our passengers, driver and vehicle. Also we reserve the right to change the itinerary to a safer destination if applicable.

Passengers' cancellation: The following cancellation charges will apply
Over 5 days prior to departure 10% of ticket fare
Between 5 days and 48 hours prior to departure 50% of ticket fare
Within 48 hours to departure 100% of ticket fare

Tickets may be transferred to an alternative departure date, subject to the Company's approval and date available. This transfer must be undertaken within one month of the original booking date. A transfer charge will apply of £1.00 per passenger to cover administration charges.

The Company cannot guarantee the same numbered seats as given on the ticket issued as operational circumstances may necessitate alterations.

Children under 4 years of age travel free, providing they are not occupying a seat (one child per paying adult) Children aged 4-14 at child fare must be accompanied by an adult. There is a £1.50 reduction on child price unless already stated.

Seat belts are fitted to all vehicles to government legislation standards and must be worn.

No pets allowed, other than guide dogs.

It may occasionally be necessary for us to reallocate seat numbers for passengers travelling singly.

Liverpool and Chester Christmas Shopping Weekend
